- 1880 Train** Several daily trips from Hill City & Keystone. A 20-mile ride on a vintage steam train like the ones that helped settle the West. Admission.
- Adams Museum & House** Deadwood. Museums explore Deadwood's legendary past. Donations encouraged at the Adams Museum; admission at Historic House.
- Angostura State Recreation Area** Hot Springs. A water enthusiast's haven for fishing, swimming, boating or a day on the beach. Admission.
- Badlands Petrified Gardens** Kadoka. Unique park featuring the Badlands' largest petrified trees and logs, fossils and fluorescent mineral exhibit. Admission.
- Bear Country U.S.A.** Rapid City. Drive-thru wildlife park, with more than 25 species of North American wildlife roaming free. Admission.
- Beautiful Wonderland Cave** between Nemo & Sturgis. You'll be guided at an easy pace along cool, well-lit passages. View the famous 40 ft. icicle fence. Admission.
- Beaver Lake Water Park** 3.5 mi. W of Custer, SD on Hwy 16. Open 1-7pm daily. Pools 9am-9pm. Everyone welcome. 1-800-346-4383. Admission.
- Big Thunder Gold Mine** Keystone. Experience the 1890's Black Hills gold rush. Underground tour, gold panning and mining museum. Admission.
- Black Hills Balloons** Custer. Traditional hot air balloon flight over Custer with champagne and other amenities. Admission.
- Black Hills Caverns** Rapid City. Nature's masterpiece of underground wilderness, 28 different cave formations in three-level wind caverns. Admission.
- Black Hills & Ft. Pierre Railroad Roundhouse** Lead. Restored 1901 museum depicting the Golden Age of Railroading in the Black Hills. Free.
- Black Hills Maze & Family Adventure** Rapid City. 37,000 sq ft, 2-level Maze. Battering cages, climbing tower, water wars & basketball. 605-343-5439. Admission.
- Black Hills Mining Museum** Lead. Exhibits and guided tours cover 130-year history of gold mining in the Black Hills. Gold panning. 605-584-1605. Admission.
- Black Hills Parrot Welfare & Education Center** Belle Fourche. Learn about endangered and exotic birds at this premier care facility. Bird store. 605-892-2336. Free.
- Black Hills Putt-4-Fun** Hot Springs. 18-hole miniature golf course complete with a waterfall, bubbling fountains and sand traps. 8 am-Dusk. Admission.
- Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary** Hot Springs. Guided bus tours to view the wild mustangs, ancient Indian petroglyphs and Crazy Horse movie set. Admission.
- Broken Boot Gold Mine** Deadwood. Underground tours of a historical gold mine. Learn how this real mine operated. Gold Panning. Admission.
- Chapel in the Hills** Rapid City. A replica of the famous Stave Church in Borgund, Norway. Unique architecture and log cabin museum. Donations.
- Circle B Ranch Chuckwagon Supper and Trail Rides** Rapid City. Trail & pony rides, shootouts, Western supper & cowboy music. Admission.
- Corn Palace** Mitchell. The unique "ear"chitecture of the Corn Palace is decorated each year with thousands of bushels of corn, grains and native grasses. Free.
- Cosmos Mystery Area** Rapid City. An awesome fun-filled tour where laws of nature seem to be defied. No one stands straight! Admission.
- Custer County 1881 Courthouse Museum** Custer. Dakota Territory Courthouse with 1874 to present. Black Hills, Lakota and pioneer displays. Admission.
- Custer State Park** 71,000-acre Park featuring camping, fishing, scenic drives, visitor centers, programs and one of the nation's largest bison herds. Admission.

- Dahl Arts Center** Rapid City. Visual art galleries, Cyclorama mural of American history, art classes, concerts, performances, kids activities and more. Admission.
- D.C. Booth Historic National Fish Hatchery** Spearfish. Hatchery features museum, historic home, fish ponds & underwater viewing windows. Free.
- Dinosaur Park** Rapid City. Towering, pre-historic life size Dinosaur replicas on beautiful Skyline Dr. Spectacular 100 mile views, gift shop, eatery. Free.
- Flags & Wheels Indoor Racing** Rapid City. Features racing Karts, GoKarts, bumper cars, slot cars, paintball, laser tag and batting cages. Admission.
- Flintstones Bedrock City** Custer. Tour Fred's Bedrock City. Stone age theme park featuring rides, playground and shows. Admission.
- Flying T Chuckwagon Supper & Show** Rapid City. Enjoy great cowboy dinners and western music appropriate for all ages. Admission.
- Fort Meade Museum** Sturgis. Cavalry outpost that was established in 1878 by the 7th Cavalry. Home of the "Star Spangled Banner." Admission.
- Four Mile Old West Town** Custer. Living history, melodramas, tours of historic town site and shopping. Admission.
- Ft. Hays Chuckwagon Supper & Show** Rapid City. Cowboy-style supper, music and comedy. Free viewing of sets from Dances with Wolves. Admission.
- George S. Mickelson Trail** Black Hills' premier trail enjoyed by hikers, bikers & horses. 109-mile-long trail with 14 trailheads, easy access & gentle slopes. Admission.
- Grand River Museum** Lemmon. Exhibits on dinosaur fossils, Native American, early ranching and homesteading. Gift shop, groups. 605-374-3911/(7574). Free.
- Gulches of Fun Amusement Park** Deadwood. Features mini-golf, Go-Karts, bumper boats, huge arcade, snack bar and Kiddie playland. Admission.
- High Plains Western Heritage Center** Spearfish. Authentic displays of pioneer, ranching, mining, rodeo, forestry and transportation history. Admission.
- Holy Terror Mini Golf** Keystone. Challenging 18-hole miniature golf course with a mining theme, set against a mountainside. 605-666-5170. Admission.
- Homestake Gold Mine Visitor Center** Lead. Surface tour of the largest gold mine in the Western Hemisphere. Mining video, artifacts and gold panning. Admission.
- Mammoth Site** Hot Springs. Indoor working paleontological site where more than 58 mammoths and over 80 other species have been unearthed. Admission.

- Museum at Black Hills Institute** Hill City. Paleontological museum featuring T. Rex "Stan" along with dozens of other dinosaurs and fossils. Admission.

- Oglala Lakota College Historical Center** Kyle. Photographs & artwork displays that chronicle the history of the Oglala Lakota. Free.
- Old Governors Mansion** Rapid City. Experience history as you tour this 1936 mansion where Governors of South Dakota lived. Admission.
- Old MacDonald's Farm** Rapid City. Petting farm offering pony and train rides, pig races and playground. Hand feed, pet and bottle feed animals. Admission.
- Paradise Valley Trail Rides** Nemo. Experienced wranglers lead 1, 2 or 3-hour trail rides across creeks, lush valleys and pine forests. 605-578-1249. Admission.
