Presentation image: What do all of these have in common?

Person 1: Can you figure out what all these things have in common? Take responses and ask Person 2: Do you have any idea what they all have in common?

Person 2 makes up a silly answer.

Person 1: All the items have come about, in some way, from those who believe in Jesus and accept His teachings. Through the power of His Holy Spirit, Jesus has changed millions of lives for the better. No one else comes even remotely close to impacting the world as Jesus has. Every day this week, we'll take a look at some of the ways Jesus has impacted our world.

Presentation image: Jesus's Impact on Education

Today we'll take a look at how followers of Jesus have impacted education. And since we're talking about edu-

cation, it seems fitting to take a fun quiz to see what we know. Read these and stand up if you think they're true. Stay seated if you think they're false.

Presentation images: Make up your own examples on the blank backgrounds provided. For example, Mr. Matt sleeps with a Mickey Mouse nightlight; Miss Theresa has five pet alligators; Miss Linda won a trophy for jumping rope.

Tell if they are true or false. Then say:

What does this have to do with Jesus? The fact that you can read or will learn to read shows an amazing way followers of Jesus have impacted our world.

You see, God communicates with us through His written Word, called the Bible. And His followers have realized the importance of learning to read so they can study His Word and learn more about Him.

Those who believe in Jesus and want to follow His commands to preach the gospel to every tribe and nation have established schools throughout the world, even in the most remote jungles, to teach people to read so they can learn about Jesus for themselves.

Christians have also helped to establish a written language for many groups who have never had one. They've taught many people to read the Bible in their own languages.

Presentation image: Which college was started for Christian reasons?

Have students clap if they think ithe answer is A, then B, then C, then D. Tell them they are all right! Then say:

Christians built colleges and universities so that people could study more about Jesus Christ and Christianity. Almost all of the first 123 colleges and universities in the USA were started by Christians to prepare ministers and Christian workers to spread the gospel and teach others about Jesus. Sadly, most of those schools don't teach the truth about Jesus today, but they started that way.

Remember that it really is a priceless gift to be able to read and understand the most important book, the Bible, which tells us the truth about Jesus and why He came to earth. I sure am glad the followers of Jesus have impacted education!
