## Enquête à propos des saisons

<p><b>Language Focus</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. present simple with <i>like</i></li> <li>. numbers</li> <li>. art and craft work</li> </ul>	<p><b>Expressions et vocabulaire travaillés</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. <p><b>Materials</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. Worksheet for each pupil</li> <li>. Seasons</li> <li>. Blank poster</li> </ul>	<p><b>Matériel</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>. Fiche pour chaque élève</li> <li>. Images des saisons</li> <li>. Poster vierge</li> </ul>
<p><b>Procedure</b></p> <p>1- Give each pupil a worksheet, then put them into groups. Each group member chooses 4 pupils (not in their group) whom they have to question.</p> <p>2- Pupils circulate round the class, asking each of their 4 chosen pupils questions like <i>Do you like Winter?</i> If a pupil answers yes, the questioner ticks the chart. When they have finished, they write the total number of ticks in the right hand column of their chart.</p> <p>3- Pupils work in their groups again to write final totals in the boxes below the charts. i.e. They add their totals together for Winter, then for Spring...</p> <p>4- Get class feedback on their results. What is the most popular season? Which one do they like least?</p>	<p><b>Déroulement</b></p> <p>1- Chaque élève a une fiche. Diviser la classe en groupes. Chaque membre du groupe choisit 4 camarades (différents du groupe) qu'il va questionner.</p> <p>2- Les élèves circulent dans la classe, et questionnent chacun 4 élèves en leur demandant par exemple <i>Do you like Winter? Do you like Autumn? Do you like Spring? Do you like Summer?</i></p> <p>Si un élève répond oui, l'élève fait une barre dans le tableau. Lorsqu'ils ont fini, ils écrivent le nombre total de barres dans la colonne de droite.</p> <p>3- A nouveau, travail en groupe pour écrire le nombre total dans les cases en bas de la fiche.</p> <p>4- Mise en commun des résultats. What is the most popular season? Which one do they like least?</p>
<p><b>Follow-ups</b></p> <p>1- Family survey : in their groups, or individually, pupils prepare a similar questionnaire for their family. However, this time they take it home over a weekend and ask 3 members of their family (or friends) which season they like the best. In the next lesson get each pupil to tell you their results. <i>My mother likes Winter, my brother likes Autumn...</i></p> <p>As they do this, keep a record on the board (draw each vegetable and put a tick next to it each time it is mentioned).</p> <p>You can then let the class decide which is the most and least popular season.</p> <p>2- Seasons poster : bring some pictures of the seasons to class (or ask the pupils to draw some details of the seasons). Pupils cut and glue them on a poster. They decorate and glue labels with the name of the students all around.</p>	<p><b>Autres activités</b></p> <p>1- Enquête auprès des familles : en groupe, ou individuellement, les élèves préparent le même questionnaire pour leur famille. Cependant, cette fois, ils le prennent avec eux pendant un weekend et demandent à 3 membres de leur famille quelle saison ils préfèrent. De retour en classe, les élèves donnent les résultats de leur questionnaire. <i>My mother likes Winter, my brother likes Autumn...</i></p> <p>Pendant qu'ils disent ceci, garder une trace au tableau (image de chaque saison + barre à chaque fois qu'elle est mentionnée).</p> <p>Laisser la classe dire quelle est la saison la plus et la moins populaire.</p> <p>2- Le poster des saisons : donner des images correspondant aux caractéristiques des saisons (ou demander aux élèves de dessiner quelques caractéristiques des saisons). Ils les découpent, les collent sur le poster. Ils le décorent et collent tout autour, les prénoms des élèves qui aiment bien cette saison.</p>
