

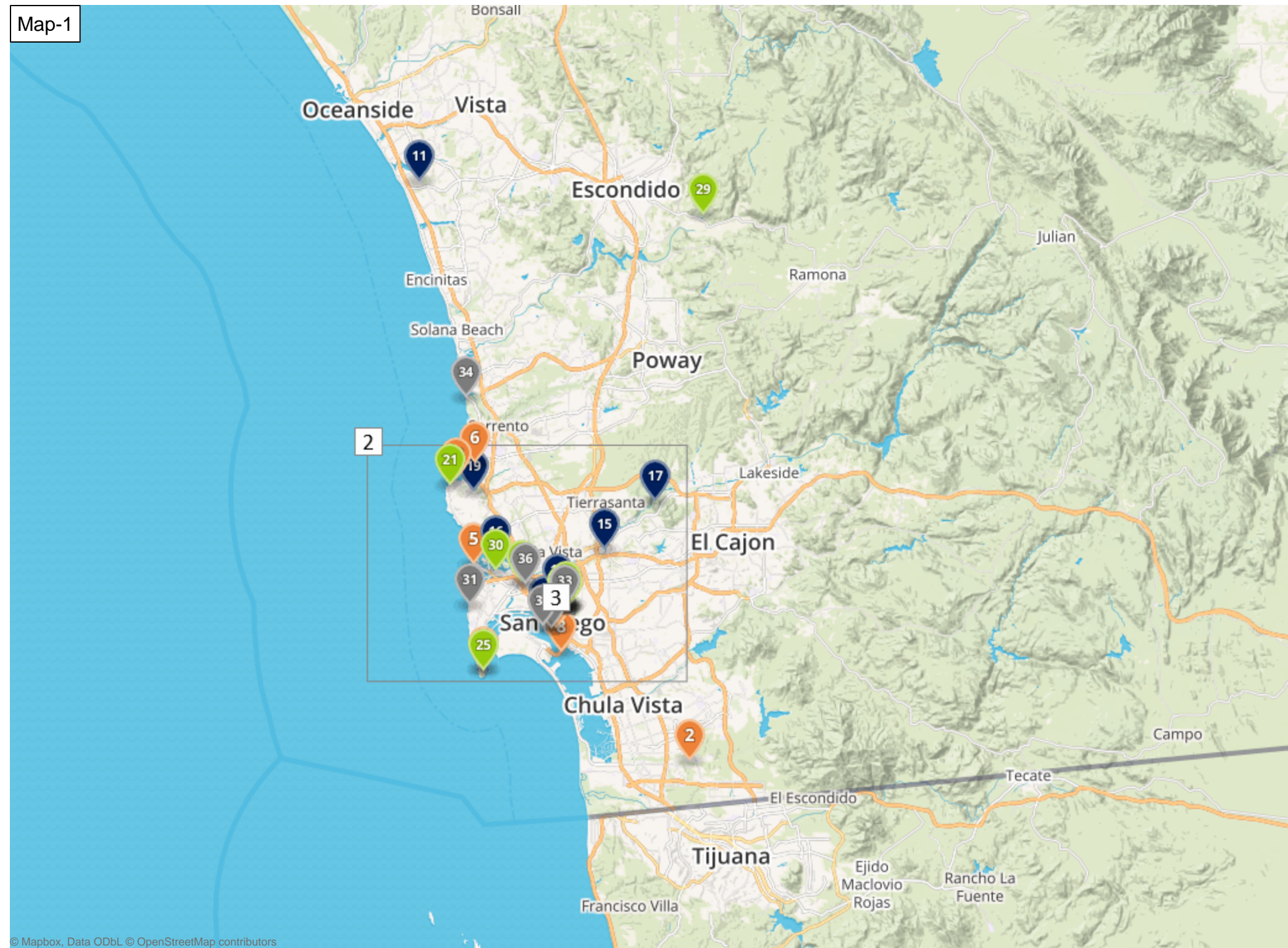

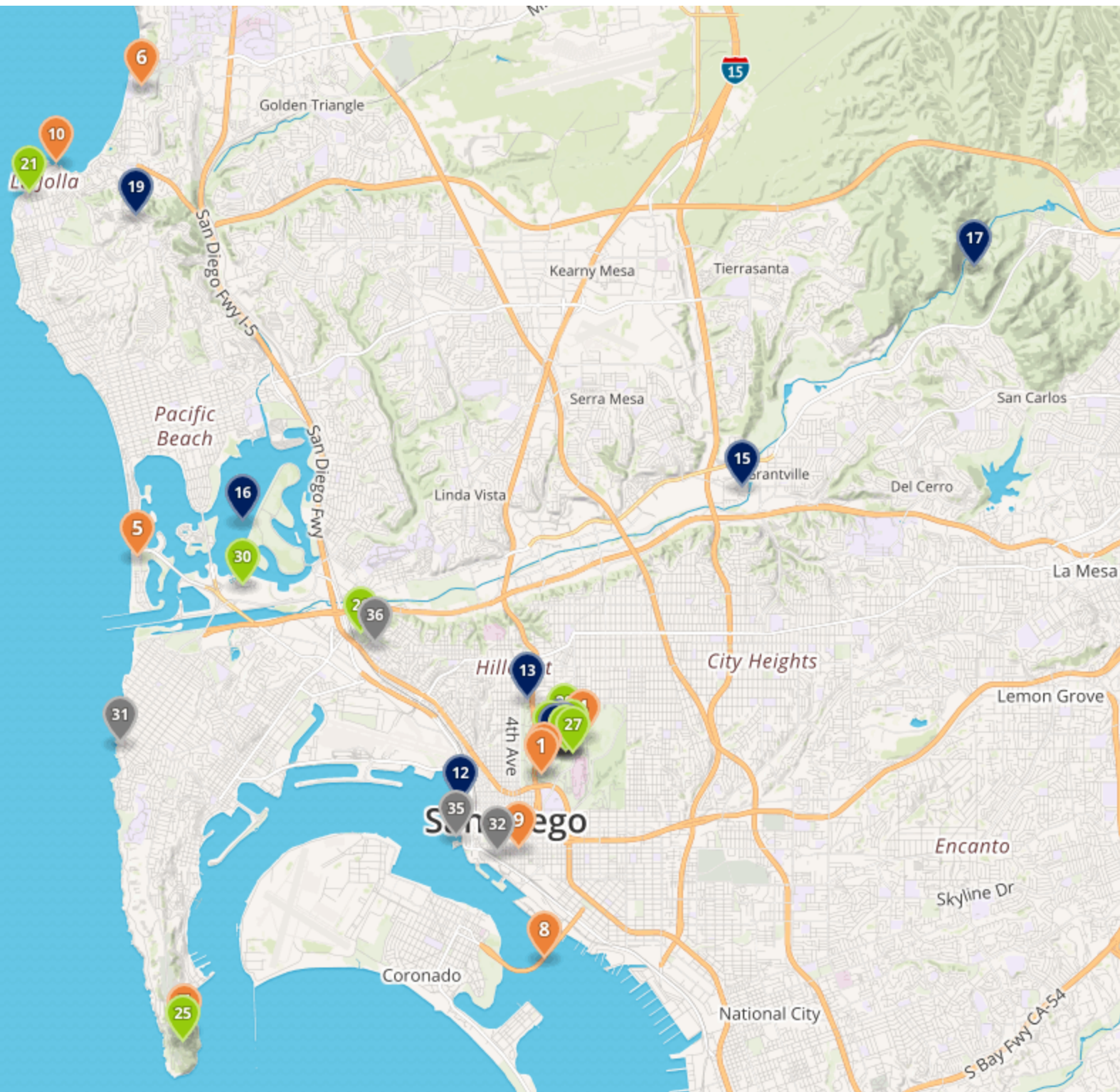

Map of Attractions

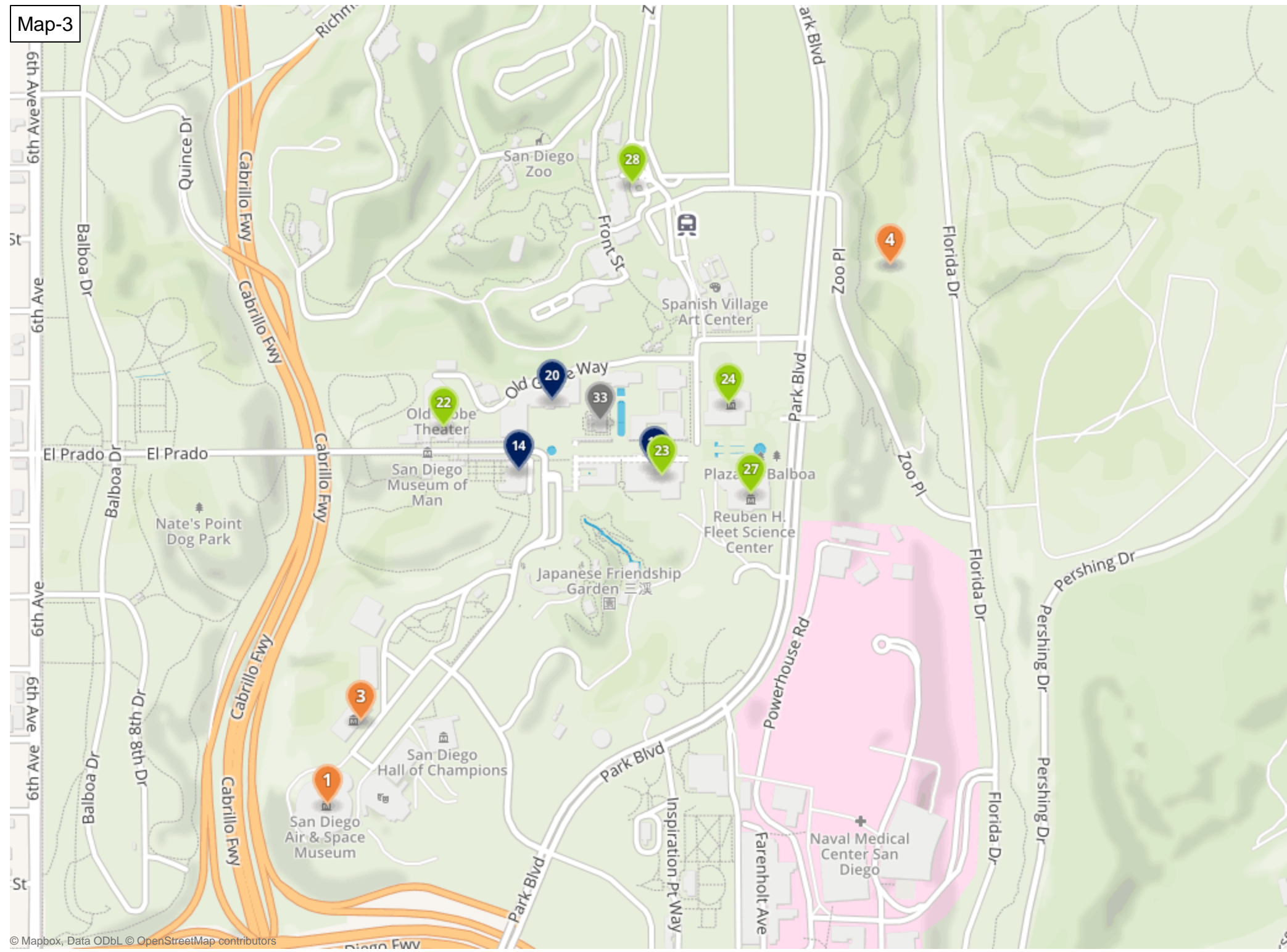

- 1** **Air & Space Museum**
Discover the remarkable tale of aviation history (Map-1,2,3)
- 2** **Aquatica Water Park**
Ultimate water park adventure with multiple adrenaline-filled rides and fun pools (Map-1)
- 3** **Automotive Museum**
Supreme collection of cars and motorcycles from all ages (Map-1,2,3)
- 4** **Balboa Park**
This urban cultural park is home to many of San Diego's museums, attractions and gardens (Map-1,2,3)
- 5** **Belmont Park**
Giant amusement and extreme sport park with historically preserved rides from 1925 (Map-1,2)
- 6** **Birch Aquarium**
A Scripps's institution, home to over 3,000 animals including sharks and giant clams (Map-1,2)
- 7** **Cabrillo National Monument**
Celebrate 16th century exploration in this national park steeped in military history and natural beauty (Map-1,2)
- 8** **Coronado Bridge**
A 2-mile long scenic bridge connecting San Diego to Coronado, supported by 30 concrete pillars (Map-1,2)
- 9** **Gaslamp Quarter**
16 blocks in downtown San Diego incorporating 94 historical buildings from the Victorian era (Map-1,2)
- 10** **La Jolla Cove**
Small, beautiful beach within an ecological reserve, popular among snorkelers and scuba divers (Map-1,2)
- 11** **Legoland California**
Iconic amusement park with over 60 rides and attractions suitable for kids aged 2 - 12 (Map-1)
- 12** **Maritime Museum**
Home to one of the largest collections of historic sea vessels in the world (Map-1,2)
- 13** **Marston House**
Historical House museum representing the Arts and Crafts Movement with stunning gardens (Map-1,2)
- 14** **Mingei International Museum**
Celebrating the 'art of the people' through a diverse collection spanning 140 countries and thousands of years (Map-1,2,3)
- 15** **Mission Basilica San Diego de Alcalá**
Beautiful old basilica established in 1759 and considered the birthplace of Christianity in the US (Map-1,2)
- 16** **Mission Bay Park**
The largest man-made aquatic park in the US with multiple recreation options (Map-1,2)
- 17** **Mission Trails Regional Park**
7,200 acre oasis close to San Diego, popular for fishing, hiking and horse-riding activities (Map-1,2)
- 18** **Model Railroad Museum**
World's largest operating model railroad museum (Map-1,2,3)
- 19** **Mount Soledad**
822 ft hill affording spectacular panoramic views of San Diego, home to controversial memorial cross (Map-1,2)
- 20** **Museum of Art**
Works from 5000 BC to modern times, specializing in Old Masters (Map-1,2,3)
- 21** **Museum of Contemporary Art**
Home to 4,700 works of contemporary art from the 1950s until the present day (Map-1,2)
- 22** **Museum of Man**
Anthropological museum focusing on history of western Americas pre-Columbia (Map-1,2,3)
- 23** **Museum of Photographic Arts**
Presents the finest examples of photographic art from 19th century until today (Map-1,2,3)
- 24** **Natural History Museum**
Showcasing the natural history of Southern California and surrounding areas (Map-1,2,3)
- 25** **Old Point Loma Lighthouse**
1855 lighthouse which once served as a beacon for sailors entering San Diego Bay (Map-1,2)
- 26** **Old Town State Historic Park**
Commemorating the early days of San Diego Town through preserved buildings in the Old Town district (Map-1,2)
- 27** **Reuben H. Fleet Science Center**
120 interactive science exhibits combined with a planetarium and giant IMAX theater (Map-1,2,3)
- 28** **San Diego Zoo**
Voted the Best Zoo in the World and home to 3,700 animals (Map-1,2,3)
- 29** **San Diego Zoo Safari Park**
One of San Diego's most popular tourist attractions with wild, endangered animals in free-range enclosures (Map-1)
- 30** **SeaWorld San Diego**
Hugely popular animal theme park, marine mammal park and oceanarium (Map-1,2)

Sunset Cliffs Natural Park

68 acre park stretching along the Pacific Ocean, where the cliffs provide the ultimate spot for sunset viewing (Map-1,2)

The New Children's Museum

Dynamic hands-on museum with exhibits to trigger curiosity and creativity among toddlers to teens (Map-1,2)

Timken Museum of Art

The jewel box of fine arts in San Diego, home to the marvelous Putnam Foundation's collection of works (Map-1,2,3)

Torrey Pines State Reserve

2,000 acre strip of wild coastal land, home to the rare Torrey pine and other local flora and fauna (Map-1)

USS Midway Museum

Onboard the iconic USS Midway which served the US navy from 1945 to 1992 (Map-1,2)

Whaley House

Historical home museum in Greek Revival style, which is rumored to be haunted! (Map-1,2)
