I am short and thin. I have a purple body. I have four legs and four arms. Who am I?

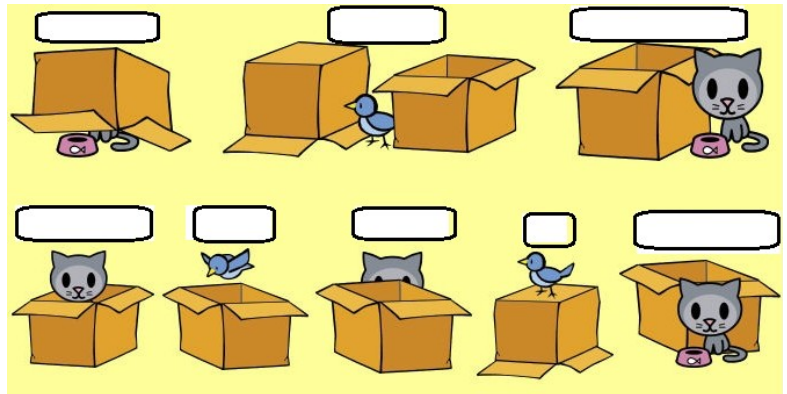
I am big and fat. I have five small eyes and a gray body. I have two arms and six legs. Who am I?

I am short and my head is my body. I have one eye and a beautiful mouth. Who am I?

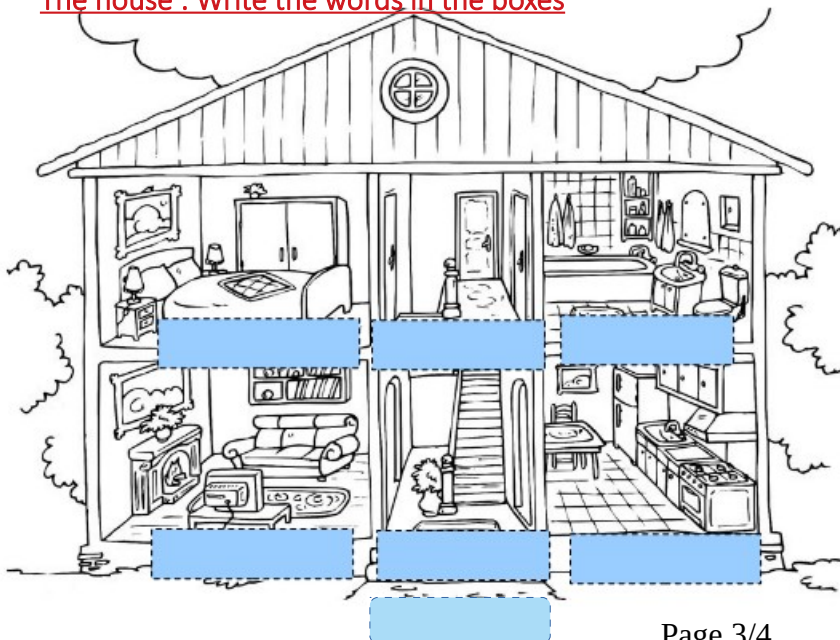
