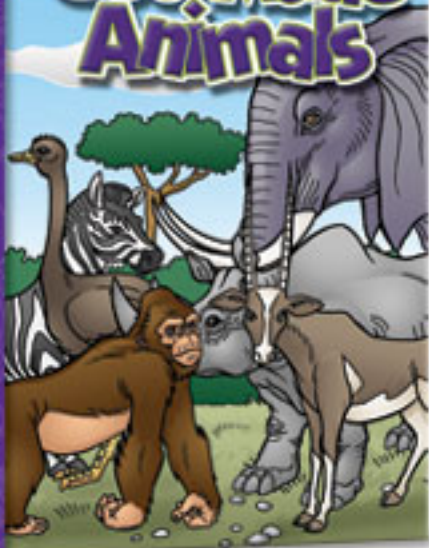

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On the sixth day of creation,

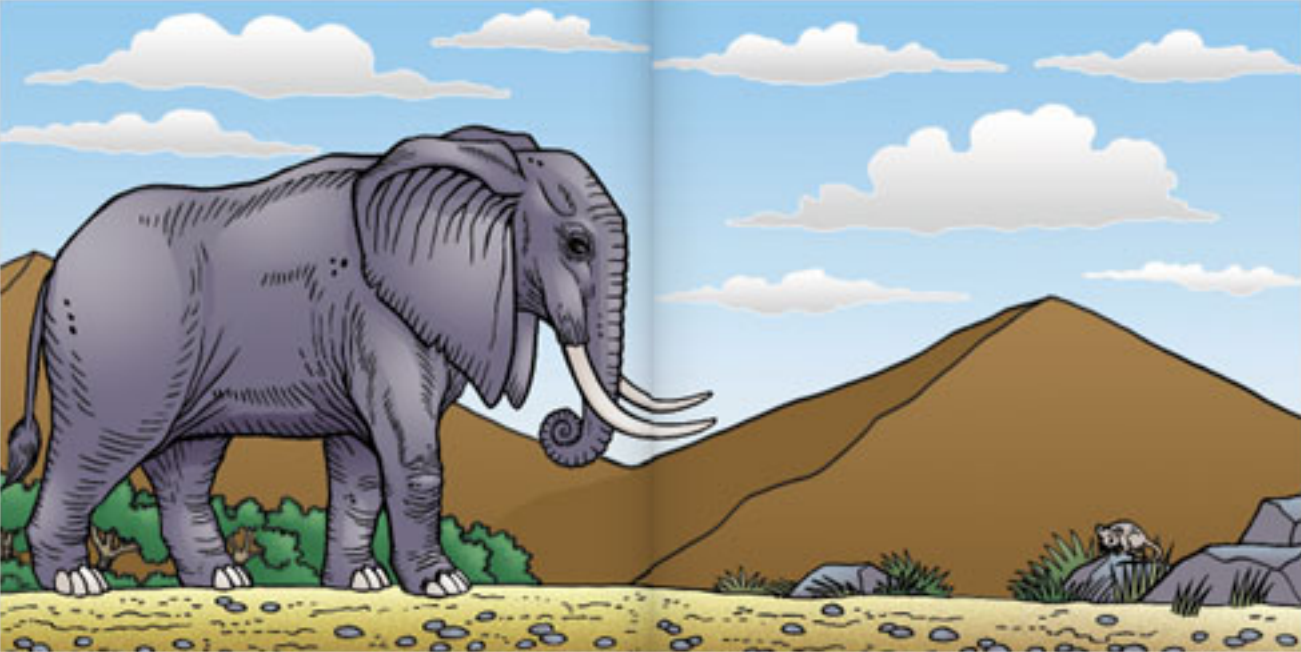
God made the animals.



God made the noisy dog.

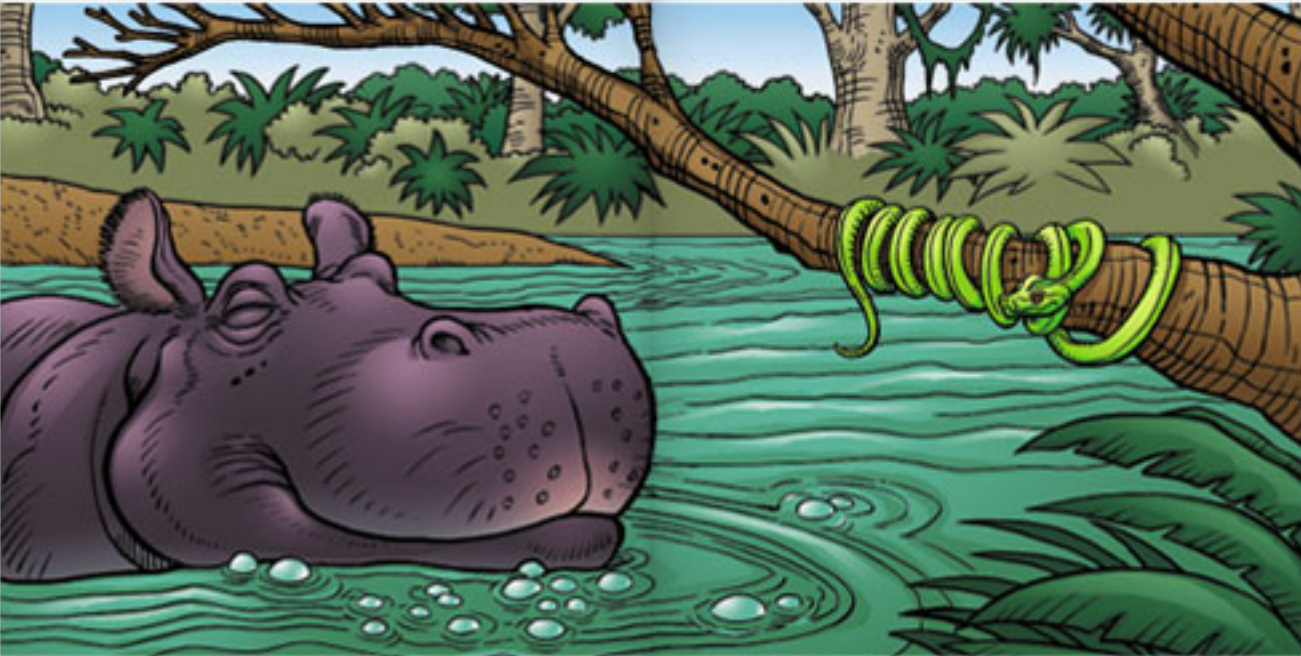


and the quiet cat.

and the little mouse.

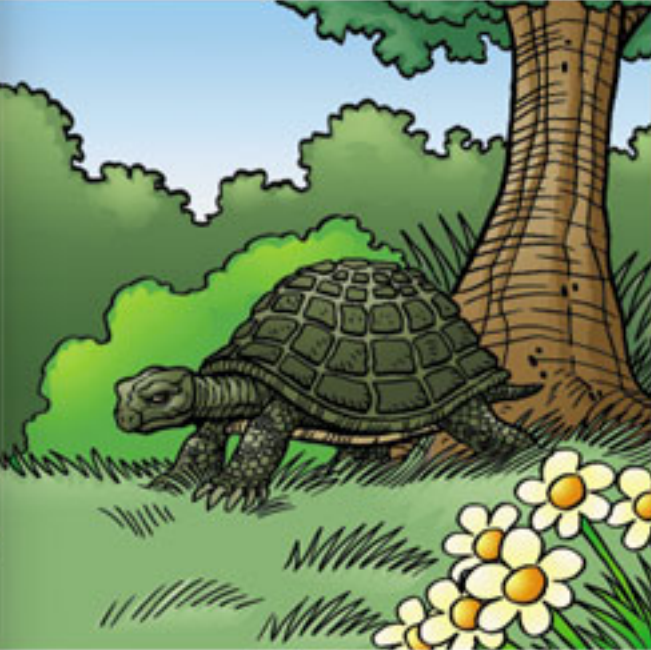


God made the fat hippo,

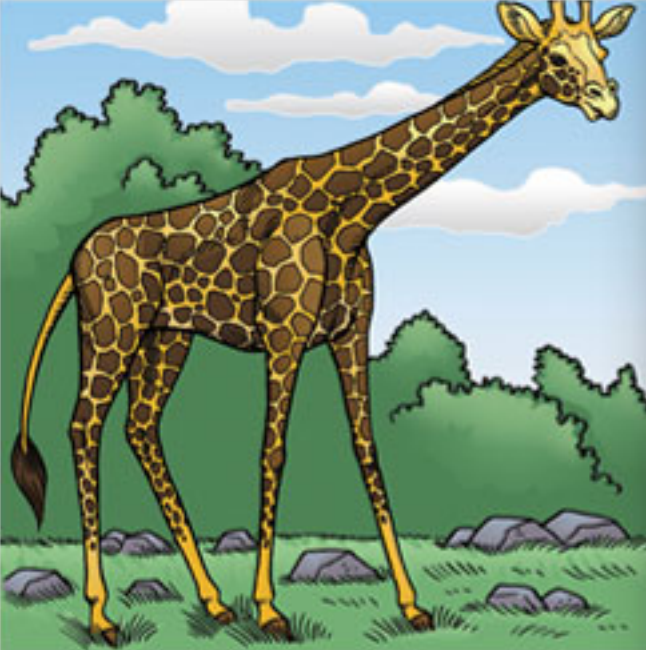
and the skinny snake.



God made the fast rabbit,



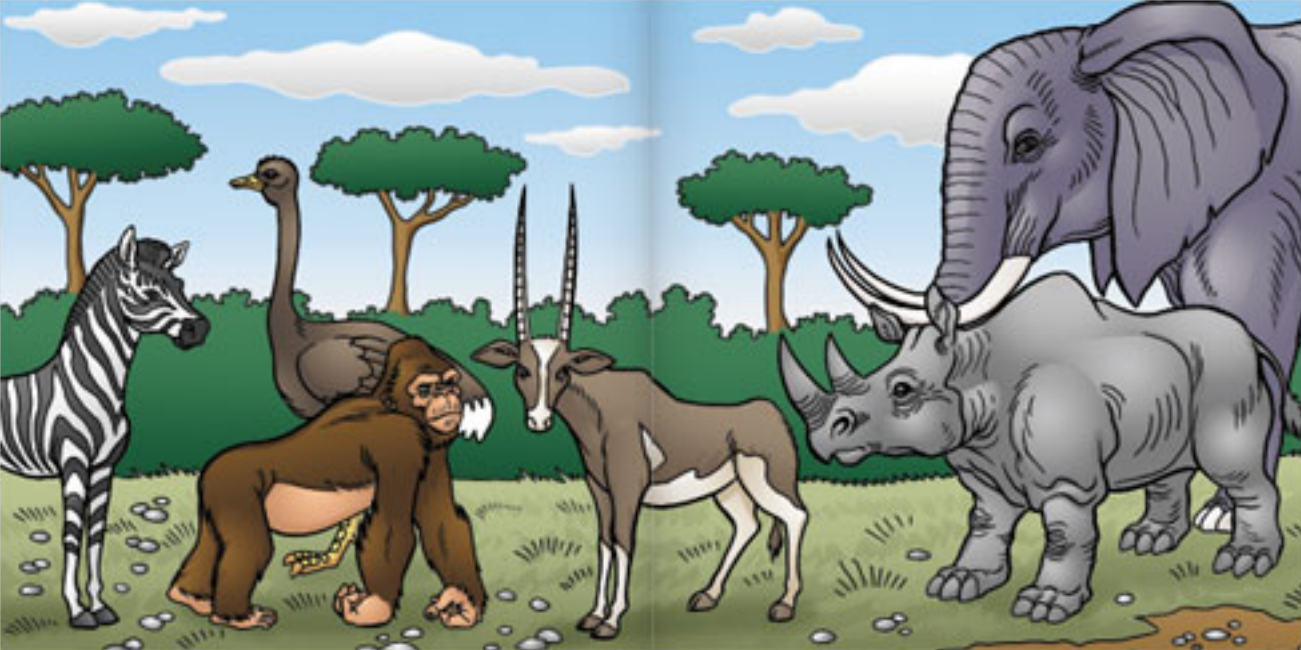
and the slow turtle.
