Naaman dipped in the river one time.

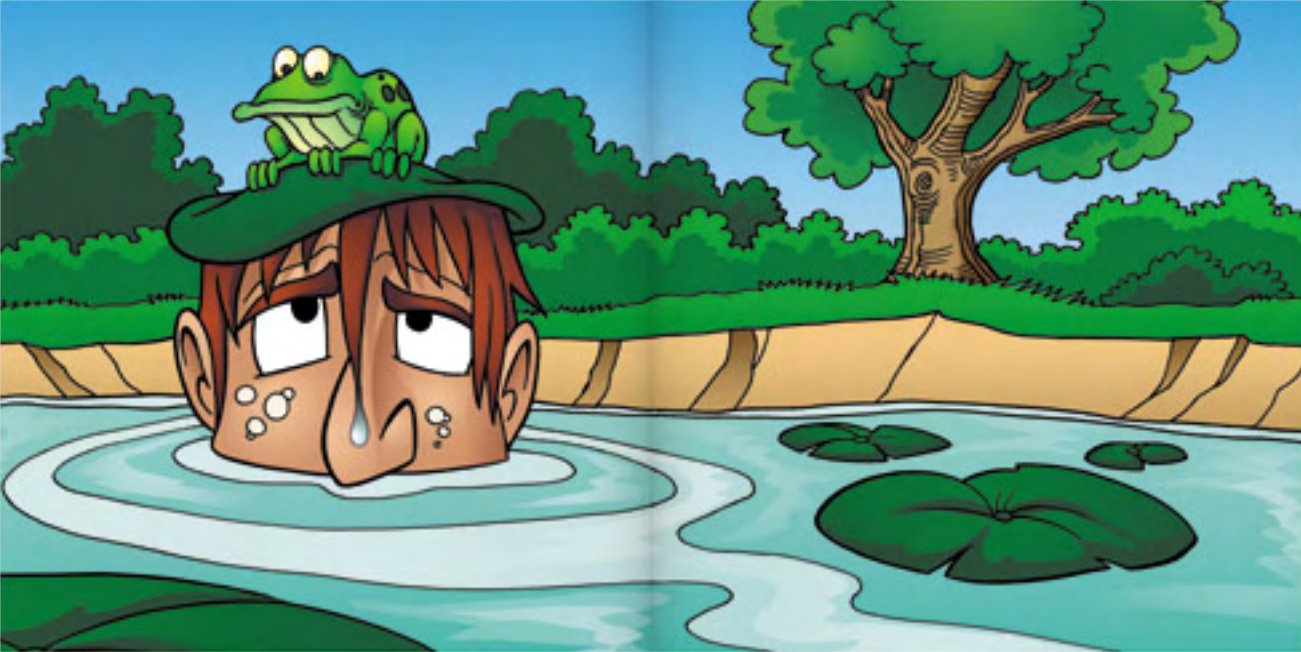
The leprosy was still there.
