Please also inform your event organizer well in advance of the session.

Poster boards will be 1m x 1m. The Local Organizing Committee will provide all the accessories needed for fixing the posters.

Poster viewing sessions will take place on Sunday, 15 July and Tuesday, 17 July through Saturday, 21 July from 16:00 - 17:30.

Presenters are encouraged to submit their completed manuscripts to COSPAR's journal, Advances in Space Research. ASR is listed on the ISI Web of Science and electronically available on Science Direct. The ASR impact factor has risen steadily in recent years (1.076 in 2010, and the average time from submission to publication on-line has decreased substantially. There are no deadlines for submission as ASR is now a regular journal. The web site with instructions for authors and for submissions is http://ees.elsevier.com/asr. Information is also available on the COSPAR web site and at the ASR Editorial Office at Mysore Assembly.

Your COSPAR paper number is **F3.2-0028-12**. This is the final number for your presentation. Papers submitted to Advances in Space Research will be assigned a journal number that will be different from the COSPAR Presentation number.

Please feel free to volunteer as chairperson for one of the sub-sessions of your event where you are not a speaker if the web indicates this position is not yet filled by the Main Scientific Organizer. If you wish to volunteer, kindly inform the event organizer and ZARM (cospar@cospar-assembly.org) by 13 June 2012.
