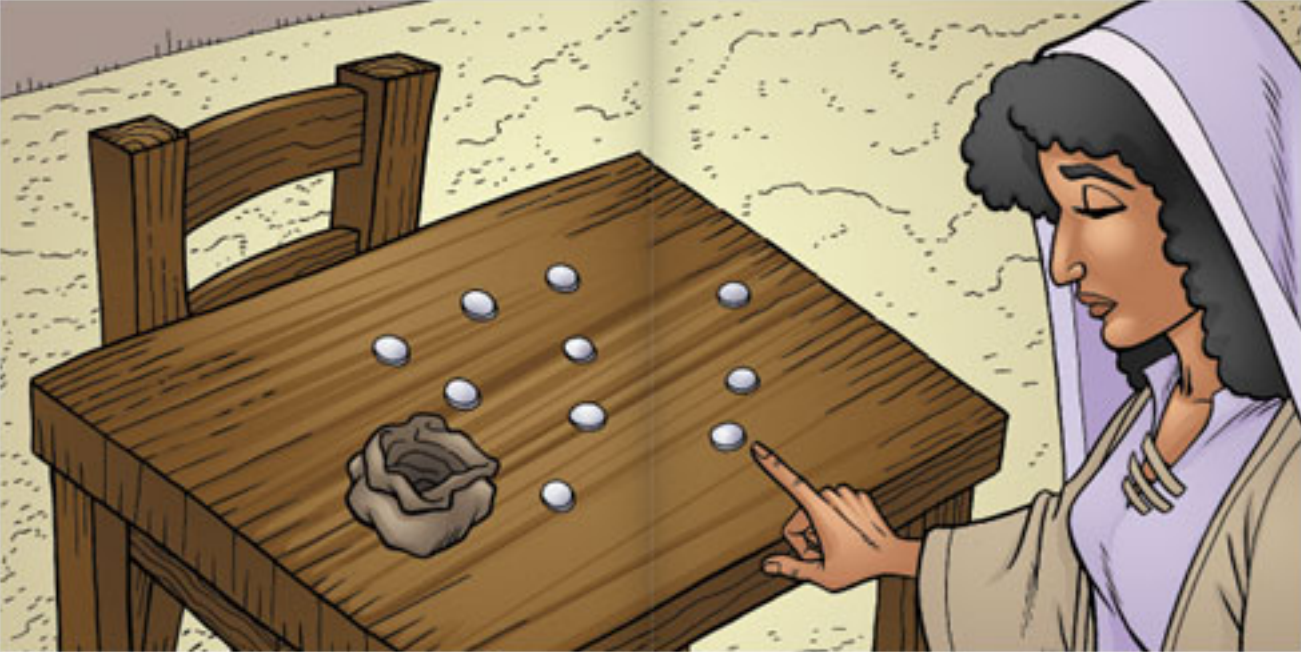

She looked under the rug. Her precious coin was not there.



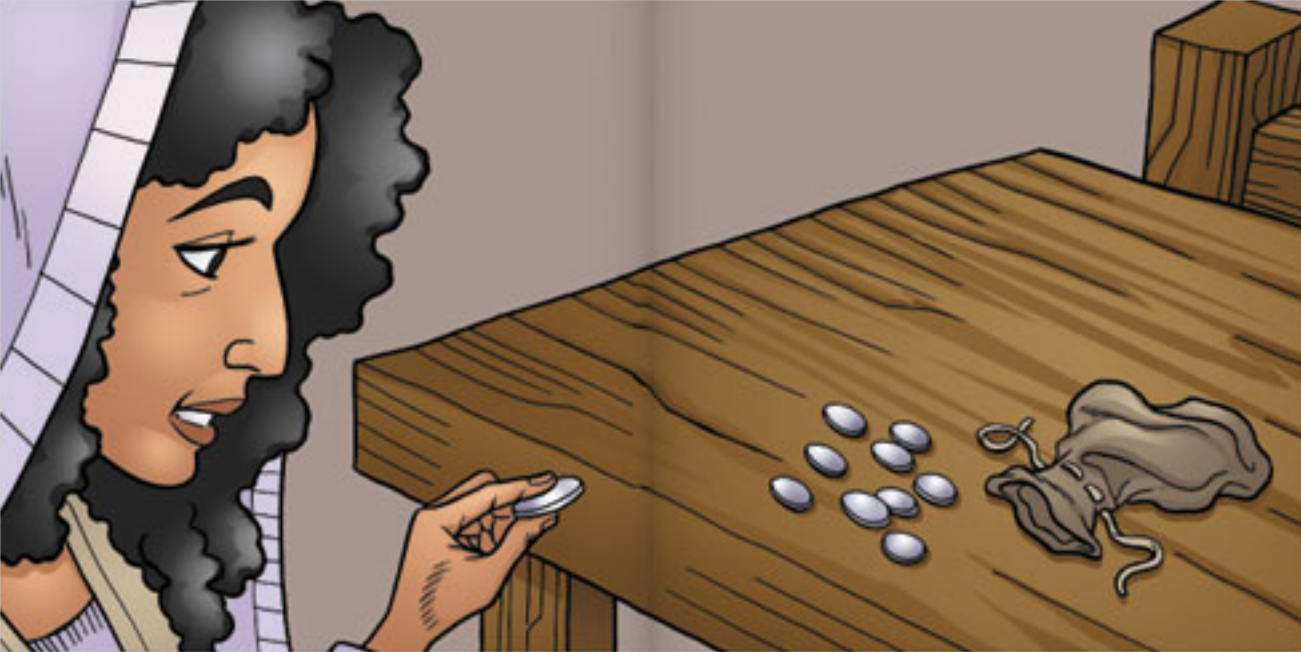
She looked under the bed. Her precious coin was not there.

Finally Abigail found her lost coin. She put it on the table. One, two, three, four, five, six,

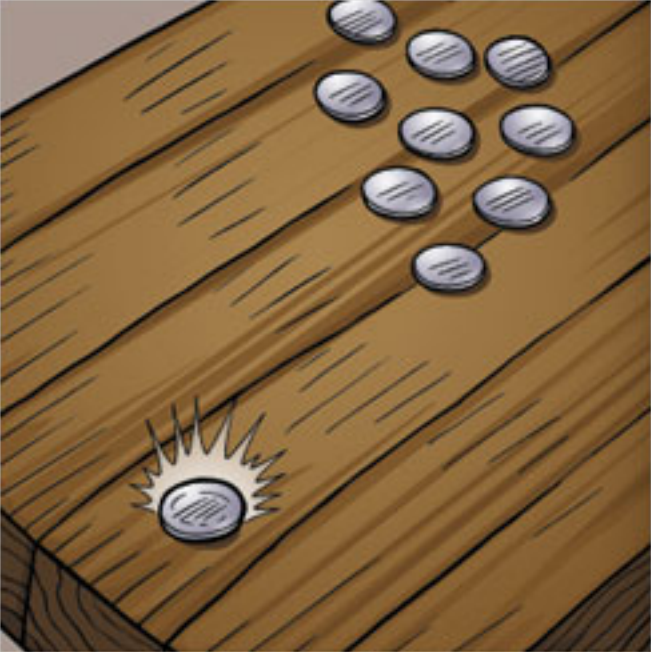
seven, eight, nine, ten! Abigail was so happy to have all of her precious coins again.
