she'd be well. And she was! Jesus was glad to help her.

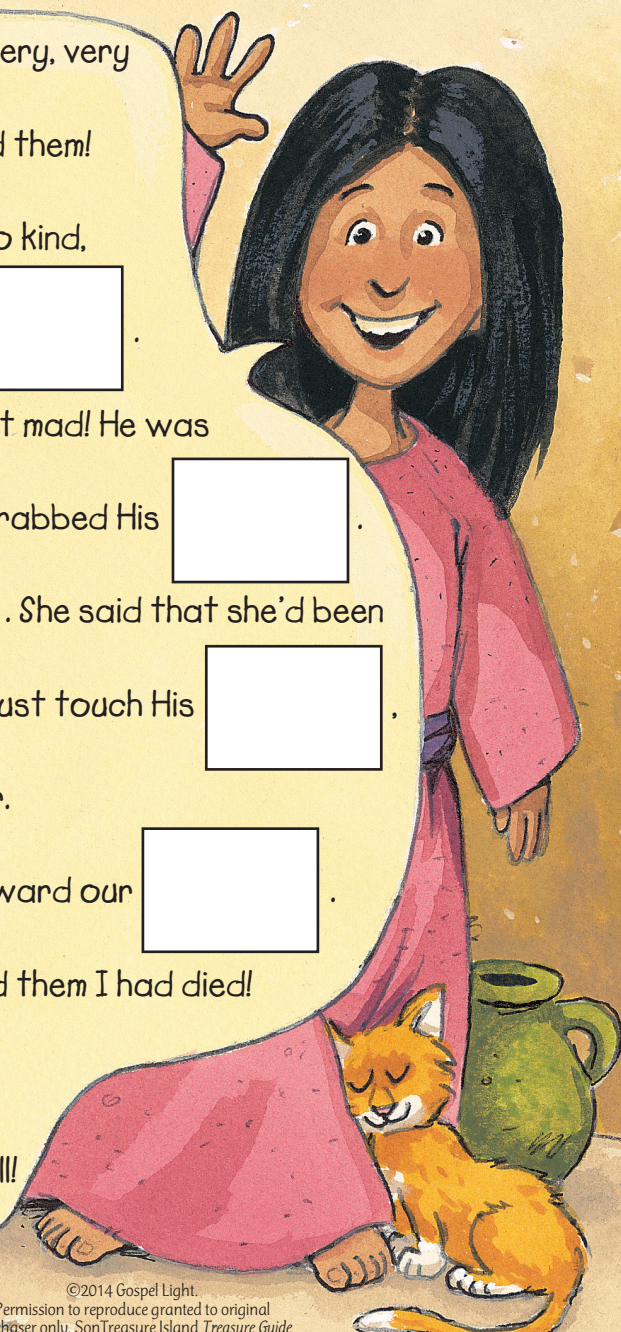
Jesus, my dad and Jesus' friends kept walking toward our .
