- Quand utilise-t-on le prétérit BE + V-ING?
   1/--> pour décrire une action en déroulement dans le passé.
- Ex: What were you doing last night at 10 o' clock? I was watching TV.
- Ainsi vous allez pouvoir jongler simultanément avec le prétérit simple et le prétérit BE+V-ING lorsque vous souhaiterez opposer action en déroulement et action soudaine.

### Ex: avec WHEN (quand) ou WHILE (pendant que)

- I was doing the washing up when you knocked at the door.
   Action en cours
   action qui interrompt
- Je peux inverser les propositions :
   When you knocked at the door, I was doing the washing up. action qui interrompt action en cours
- While I was sleeping, the telephone rang. Action en cours action qui interrompt
- He **arrived** while **I was reading** a very good book. action qui interrompt action en cours
