 Instructions: Work these out using addition column method. Remember to carry the tens or hundreds ON TOP in the right column. Please choose one

RED

1. If John has 58 toy cars and Tom has 70 toy cars, how many toy cars do they have altogether?

2. One farmer has 36 lambs and another has 87. How many lambs do the two farmers have together?

3. A grocer sold 27 bags of sweets on Monday, 35 bags on Tuesday and 18 bags on Wednesday. How many did they sell in those three days?

BLUE

1. If John has 158 toy cars and Tom has 278 toy cars, how many toy cars do they have altogether?

2. One farmer has 336 lambs and another has 287. How many lambs do the two farmers have together?

3. A grocer sold 127 bags of sweets on Monday, 135 bags on Tuesday and 18 bags on Wednesday. How many did they sell in those three days?

GREEN

1. If John has 3158 toy cars, Tom has 5278 toy cars, and Greg has 1227 cars. How many toy cars do they have altogether?

2. One farmer has 5336 lambs and another has 1287. Then one farmer sells 4038 of them, how many lambs are there altogether now?

3. A grocer sold 4127 bags of sweets on Monday, 6335 bags on Tuesday and 6778 bags on Wednesday. How many did they sell in those three days?
