



# Domaine de la Vivarié

## THE SUNFLOWER ROOM



The **sunflower** moves itself in the most direct position in front of the sun so it can get the maximum sun rays. This is symbolic of **spiritual faith** and **worship** because we follow our belief system as the sunflower moves to face the life-giving rays of the sun. The sunflower is the Greek symbol of Clytie (a water nymph) who turns into a sunflower after grieving over the loss of her love (Apollo). The mythological symbolism here is that Clytie (in the form of a sunflower) is always facing the sun, looking for Apollo's chariot to return and she might be joined again with her love.

### Description of the room :

- Maximum capacity: 3 persons (1 couple and 1 child)
- 2 single beds and a child bed
- Small living area and a desk
- Privative shower-room with simple sink, shower and WC
