


Expressing likes and dislikes with Gerund

1. Gerund:

Words that are formed using verbs and that function as a NOUN.

Verb + ing = **NOUN**



Examples

- **Writing** in English is difficult.
- **Watching** TV is my favorite pastime.

- I like **writing** in English.
- I love **going** out to restaurants.

- My cat's favorite activity is **sleeping**.
- One of his duties is **doing** homework.

- Write + ing = **writing**
- Watch + ing = **watching**
- Go + ing = **going**
- Sleep + ing = **sleeping**
- Do + ing = **doing**

2. Expressing Likes and dislikes:

Likes	Dislikes
I like	I dislike
I love	I hate
I adore	I don't like
	I abhor

Expressing likes and dislikes using the gerund:

Examples:

- I love **watching** television.
- I like **listening** to music
- I adore **playing** football.
- I don't like **watching** horror films.
- I dislike **playing** tennis
