

- A source card can have one or many information cards.
- A source card does not need have any information card (it means that you consulted the source, created a source card, but you decided to not borrow any material, so no information card).
- Any information card must correspond to a source card.
- An information card should contain only one piece of information (one idea, one opinion, etc...)
