

4. Venue map

The city of Val-de-Reuil, in Normandy region, is located about 108 km north-west from the centre of Paris.





5. Transport information

Travel by plane



- To Paris-Orly Airport (ORY):
 - ⇒ Organisers will provide a car/bus to Val-de-Reuil (about 1h30 travel);
- To Paris Charles-de-Gaulle Airport (CDG):
 - ⇒ Organisers will provide a car/bus to Val-de-Reuil (about 1h30 travel);
- To Rouen Airport (URO) by Lyon Airport (LYS) 1h15 travel by plane:
 - ⇒ Organisers will provide a car/bus to Val-de-Reuil (about 30 min travel).

Travel by train



- From Paris Saint-Lazare Station: 1h07 to 1h20 travel to Val-de-Reuil by SNCF (French train society)
 - Organisers will provide a car/bus from Val-de-Reuil's train station to the meeting point.

For departures on the Monday 5th March, organisers will provide transport to airports and train stations.

6. Accommodation

The accommodation is planned in different hotels at Val-de-Reuil. Single (one big bed) and twin (two separated beds) rooms will be available. If needed, organisers will provide transfers every day, one at morning and one at the end of the competition day.

7. Meals

All lunches and dinners will take place in a gymnasium very close to the competition facility. The first meal will be dinner on the 28th February and the last will be breakfast on Monday 5th March.



9. Competition facility

The competition facility is the Jesse Owens Stadium of Val-de-Reuil. It has 4 changing rooms for teams, 1 anti-doping room, 1 medical room, 1 call room, 1 warm-up and warm down room, 1 official/VIP room and 1 technical/computer zone.



10. Sport rules and regulations

According to the rules of INAS, the competition is opened to the following INAS' categories:

- II1 athletes with intellectual impairment
- II2 trial group for athletes with a more significant intellectual impairment e.g. Down Syndrome
- II3 athletes with high-functioning autism.

11. Medical service

There will be a permanent medical service present during each day of competition.

12. Accreditations

Eligibility of athletes: all participants should be eligible, registered within INAS Master List no later than the final entry deadline.

Accreditations will be issued to each athlete after she/he personally has shown her/his passport to the INAS officer. All staff members will also receive accreditations.

15. Team Competition

According to the INAS guidelines and in order to encourage nations to participate, the Championships will have both individual and team competition per gender (male and female). In the Team Competition each competing nation is allowed one (1) athlete only per event (the best classified in the individual competition).

Only nations with a minimum of 3 participating athletes per gender are eligible to participate in the Team Competition of this gender (male or female).

NOTE: Please note that only athletes in the II1 category are eligible for team competition.

The classification system for Team Competition is:

- n points for 1st classified;
- n-1 points for 2nd classified;
- n-2 points for 3rd classified, and so on for the other places, where (n) is the number of nations eligible for participation in the Team Competition per gender.

Example: Male Competition, 12 participating countries.

- 1st12 points
- 2nd 11 points
- 3rd 10 points
- 12th 1 point

16. Language

English if the official INAS events language. All materials and information will be available in English.

17. Ceremony items

Please bring 3 National Flags and a short version (less than 1:20 minutes) of the National Anthem on CD or USB key (you can also send the anthem by mail in MP3 format before the competition).

18. Entry fee

The price per person for the whole stay (including accommodation, meals, transport, INAS capitation tax) for this championships is 637 EUROS.

Single rooms will have an extra of 30 EUROS per day.
