# La symétrie

The grid is divided into three vertical sections by a central vertical line. Each section contains a geometric shape drawn on the grid lines. The shapes are as follows:

- Top section:** A house-like shape with a triangular roof and a rectangular base. The roof is 2 units wide and 1 unit high. The base is 2 units wide and 3 units high. The left side of the base is connected to the top-left corner of the roof.
- Middle section:** A house-like shape, identical to the one in the top section, but positioned lower on the grid.
- Bottom section:** A diamond-like shape (rhombus) with a width of 2 units and a height of 2 units. The top and bottom vertices are on the grid lines.

The right side of the grid is blank, intended for drawing the symmetrical counterparts of the shapes on the left.
