Learn about the King Holiday Bill, the legacy of MLK Jr. and American history in the late 20th century!



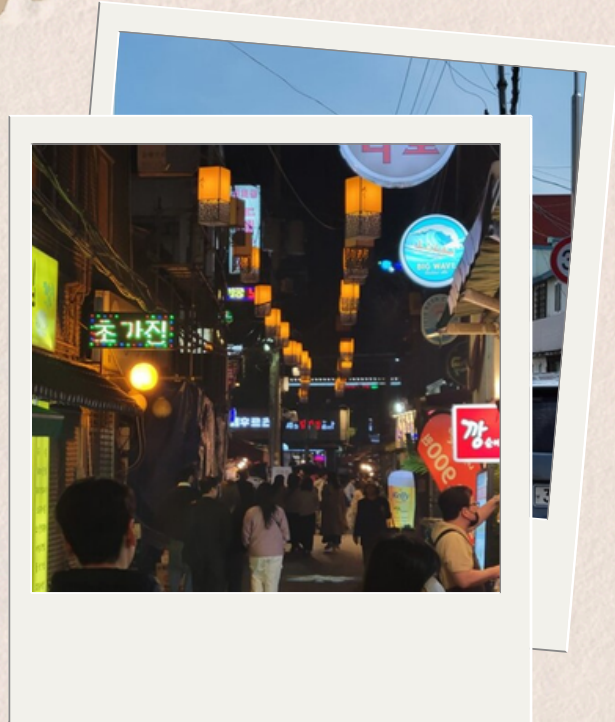




