Yarn:
Happy Cotton, Sirdar, 1 skeins



Needles:
hook: US000/3mm

Pattern Instructions



Introduction

Crochet this cute little lucky charm in about half an hour.

Starting with the rear centre of the clover then the front centre attaching the two together with the clover leaves popping a shiny penny in the centre before finishing.

The stitches may look a bit complicated but once you've finished one, you'll want a whole field of them ☑



rear



Row 1

MR, ch3 (counts as 1st dc), 1dc, ch3, 2dc, ch3, 2dc, ch3, 2dc, ch3, slst into top of 1st dc, ch1, fasten off & cut yarn



front



Row 1

MR, ch3 (counts as 1st dc), 1dc, ch3, 2dc, ch3, 2dc, ch3, 2dc, pull ring closed, ch3, slst into top of 1st dc.

Row 2

now with wrong sides facing, attach the centre rear to the front rear with the following stitches that create the clover leaves;

slst into top of next dc and the top of the 1st dc of the centre rear (see pic), *sc in 3ch sp, ch2, 3dc, hdc, 3dc, ch3, slst all in the same 3ch sp, slst in next 2dc,* repeat from *to* twice more, insert a shiny penny, sc in 3ch sp, ch2, 3dc, hdc, 3dc, ch3, slst all in the same 3ch sp, slst into top of dc, (form the clover stem) ch5, sc in 2nd ch from hook, slst in each of the next 3ch, slst into next dc, fasten off and weave in ends ☒
